The complete program is run by volunteers. The organization's mission statement: "In our world today, it is easy for neighbors to lose touch with neighbors. Causeway exists to develop caring communities in which neighbors share time and skill in response to the needs of each other." A volunteer is matched with an older adult or an individual with disabilities in order to give assistance as needed, enabling recipients to maintain a sense of well-being and independence in their own homes.
